The Summer

Now we have started the second summer term and we are near to the summer holidays, homework tasks will be based on your experience of the summer. Choose as many of the following tasks as you wish.

- **Art task** – Sketch, paint, create a project or labelling a photo to represent what the Summer means to you.
- **History task** – Research what summer life has been like across living memory. Then create a fact-file showing similarities and differences between summer life now and in the past. You can choose one place you know well, a city, country or the entire world.
- **Geography task** – Create a map of one town, city or country. Research events that will occur this summer and label where these events will take place. Be sure to include a map key and a scale.
- **Music task** – Create a short song or recording of as many different summer sounds as possible. For example; people laughing at the park, waves crashing at the beach etc.
- **English task** – Think of your favourite summer memory. Write a detailed description of the memory. Describe: where it took place, who was in the memory, how it made you feel, the smells and sounds, whether you have had similar memories since then. Try to include: the past tense, clear paragraphs, fronted adverbials, high-level verbs, adjectives and adverbs, similes, metaphors, inverted commas for speech, expanded noun phrases and both types of apostrophes.
- **Maths task** – Find as many different 3D shapes and angles as you can in your local environment. Also, use different objects to construct different 3D and 2D shapes. See the photos below for inspiration:
