Maths: In maths this half term, we will be focussing on Place value. Using place value we will be able to explore Roman numerals, how to round to the nearest 10, 100 and 1000 and then finally using the column method to add and subtract.

English: During our English lessons, this half term we will be writing a descriptive piece of writing and a non-chronological report based on the visual literacy video the Dragon Slayer. We will be learning lots of new skills and then incorporating these skills into our writing. This will be achieved through planning our writing, drafting our writing and finally editing our writing so we can assess the effectiveness of our work and make improvements.

Science: During Science this half term we will be looking at the topic 'Animals including humans.' Throughout this topic we will be exploring the functions and parts of the human digestive system and then looking at different types of teeth and their purpose. We will also have the opportunity to plan our own investigation and pose questions based on this topic.

Creative Links: Art will be our focus for creative links this half term. This will involve us learning skills to help us draw, paint and collage landscapes. We will then apply these skills independently into our own art projects.
