# Update June 2018

During the last half term, year 6 pupils sat their statutory assessment tests (SATs). They put in tremendous effort and excelled together. These tests focused on reading, maths and GPS. A focus for this half term will therefore be on improving their writing, whilst still keeping pupils thinking about and developing in maths and reading.

## Maths

In maths, the focus for the class will be on applying mathematical knowledge to solve problems and investigations, both individually and in groups. Pupils that still need to develop their arithmetic, both mentally and formally, will work to remove any gaps in their knowledge and understanding.

## English

This half term, we will be focusing on writing in a range of genres.

Pupils will be given the opportunity to choose from different genres, and write about things that interest them. They will also edit and improve their previous written texts, to show their new understanding of GPS. Finally, they will apply their writing skills to cross-curricular writing.

Spelling will continue to be a focus, linked to year group words, spelling rules, technical words and specific individual words that pupils find difficult to spell.

## Science

In science, we will be studying animals and their habitats: pupils will give reasons for classifying plants and animals based on specific characteristics, and describe how living things are classified into broad groups according to common observable characteristics and based on similarities and differences, including microorganisms, plants and animals.

We will carry out an investigation, planned by the pupils, to discover the best conditions for mould to grow in.

## Creative Links

We are continuing our study of music this half term.

Pupils have already been learning how to describe and talk about music, accurately, and using technical language. Next, they will be performing a song stylistically, and developing vocal warm ups. Then after practising with instruments, and creating improvisations, they will be composing music and recording it using musical notation.
